### Safety NZ Week 2009 7 - 13 September

We have some wonderful posters and other resources for your practices for this important week.

Posters say:

- For children, this can be the most dangerous road to play on (shows driveway up to garage)
- 40% of NZ homes have dangerously hot water (shows melting plastic duck)
- Every 48 seconds, someone in NZ has an injury at home (shows people making numerals 4 & 8)
- Falls make up over half of all home injuries (shows building block graphs)
- One in seven NZers were injured in the home last year (shows 7<sup>th</sup> man falling)
- Each year over 36,000 Kiwis require hospitalization from home injuries (shows map of NZ)
